Parent Information: Bags, Coats and Equipment

In order to minimise sources of contamination in school, children are required to keep to a minimum the things that they bring in from home.

Some children may need to bring in a packed lunch (named) and most children will bring in a school water bottle (named). (see Lunches and Drinks)

Children may bring in a coat to wear in cold or wet weather. This coat will be kept on their peg during the day. If the weather is not likely to be cold or wet, children do not need to bring a coat. All coats **must** be named. Children must take their coat home each night to allow for the deep cleaning of classrooms.

Children will not need to bring any equipment into school. All equipment they need will be provided by school and will be allocated to them in their own pack, which will be kept in school.

Children **must** not bring any personal items into school.

Children will not need to bring a PE kit bag to school as they will wear their PE kit and sports trainers on their PE day. This day will be communicated to you by the class teacher. (see PE and Sport)

Children will be allocated a weekly reading book or books and a reading diary. These will be taken home each week to be read and signed. (see Home Reading). Children will be able to use their school reading book bag for this or their school bag. All bags must be named and taken home each night to allow for deep cleaning of the classrooms.
